Cusp solid timber cladding is manufactured from 100% sustainable plantation-grown eucalypt hardwood. Our Rosetop Oak cladding is incredibly versatile and capable of lasting 40-60 years.

Timber cladding excels in both heat and sound insulation, effectively trapping warmth in the home and containing sound.

Rosetop Oak (Eucalyptus Grandis) is a beautiful blond timber with buttery bronze, and rosy, pink tones, that perfectly bridges the gap between urban structures. It is native to Australia and is one of the most productive plantation eucalypts when grown in the right environment. As such, it is highly accessible.

Technical details

Rosetop Oak outperforms concrete, steel and aluminium in heat retention. It has a class 2 above-ground durability rating (15-40 years). It is malleable. It can be easily sanded and machines well to deliver a smooth finish. It will readily accept paint, stain, polish, and oiling. It is not susceptible to Lyctid Borer and has a BAL (Bushfire resistance rating) of 12.5 – 19 All AS3959 required applications.
